

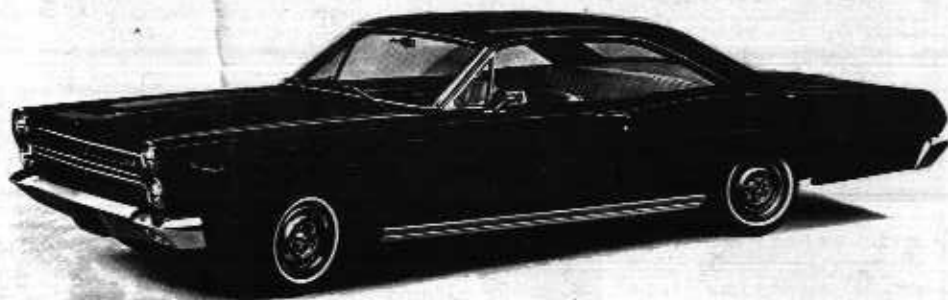

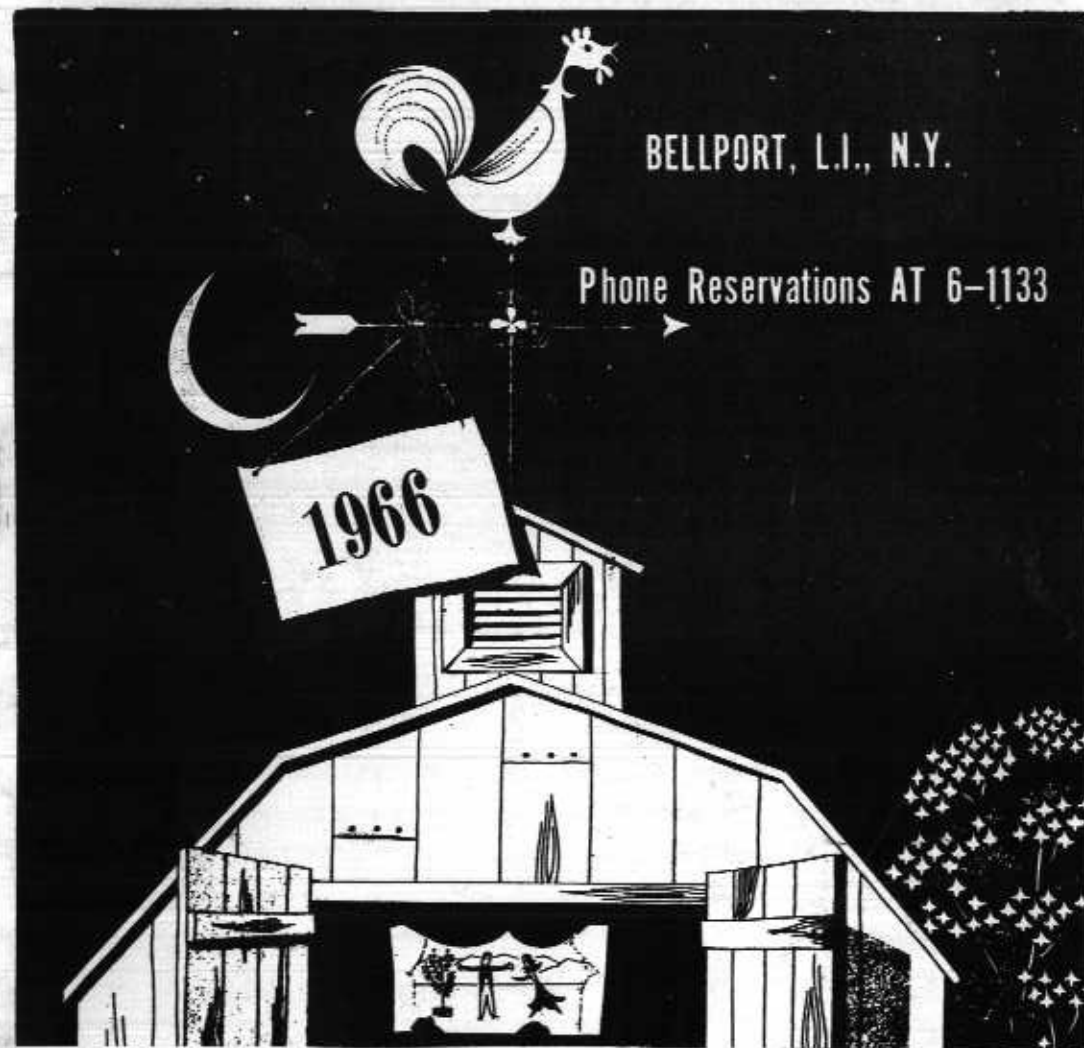

Student productions are given in the Red Barn Theatre, next to the Playhouse, every Sunday afternoon in July and August. Admission is free.
