

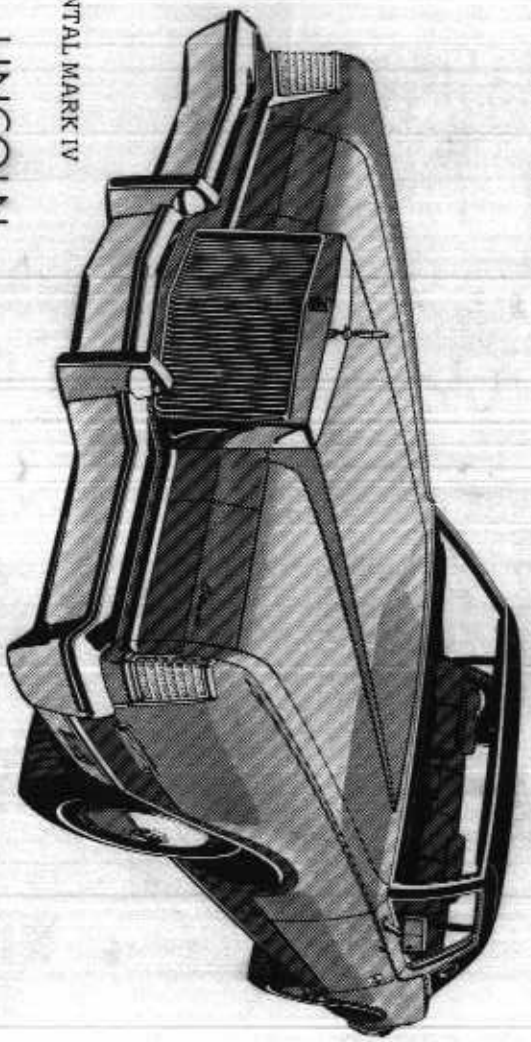

COLLEGE, COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY, S.U.N.Y. - AT BROCKPORT, COLLEGE OF WILLIAM AND MARY, VASSAR, PRATT INSTITUTE, TOWSON, CORNELL, EASTERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY, MEMPHIS STATE UNIVERSITY, STANFORD, QUEENS COLLEGE, JULLIARD, FLORIDA STATE, DUKE UNIVERSITY, and MARYLAND INSTITUTE.

**Showcase Students.** Each summer a group of students live on the adjoining Gateway estate and study drama, dance, music, and art. A concentrated summer semester in the performing arts prepares them for a career in the theatre. They attend daily classes and perform regularly. Many Gateway students have gone to make a name for themselves in television, the stage, and motion pictures.
