

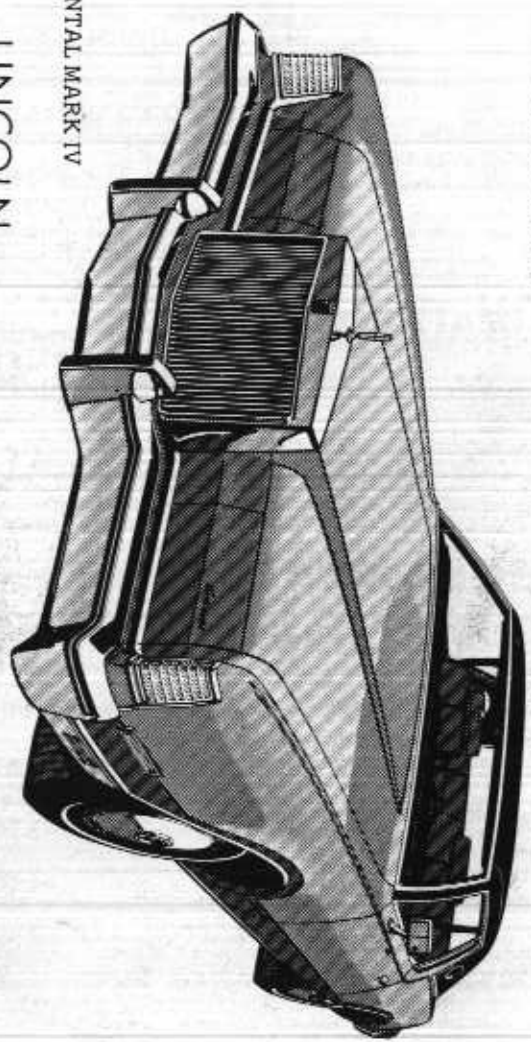

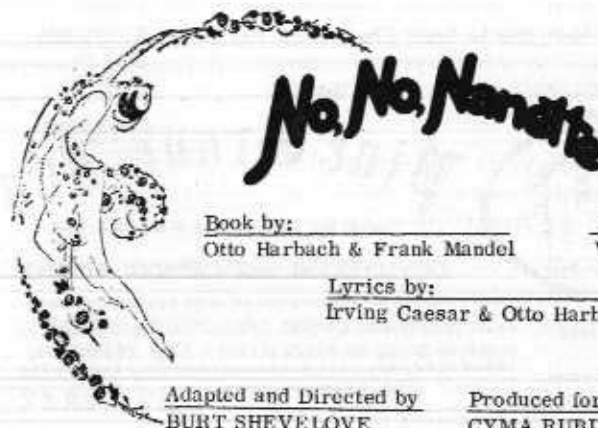

Y. - AT BROCKPORT, COLLEGE OF WILLIAM AND MARY, VASSAR, PRATT INSTITUTE, TOWSON, CORNELL, EASTERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY, MEMPHIS STATE UNIVERSITY, STANFORD, QUEENS COLLEGE, JULLIARD, FLORIDA STATE, DUKE UNIVERSITY, and MARYLAND INSTITUTE.

Showcase Students. Each summer a group of students live on the adjoining Gateway estate and study drama, dance, music, and art. A concentrated summer semester in the performing arts prepares them for a career in the theatre. They attend daily classes and perform regularly. Many Gateway students have gone to make a name for themselves in television, the stage, and motion pictures.
