It All Started With "Let's Put On a Show"

In search of the secret of the survival and longevity of the Gateway Playhouse on a dying-out circuit, one needn't dig too deeply: it's all in the family.

"The oldest summer stock theater on Long Island," according to its co-producer, John Hodge, is nearing the end of its 35th consecutive season in Bellport.

Although the 27-year-old Mr. Hodge is not a member of the family — he came to the playhouse as a stage manager in 1980 — Paul Allan, 24, the son of Gateway's owners and its former operators, Stan and Ruth Allan, is currently managing the theater, with Mr. Hodge. Mr. Hodge said that Mr. Allan's parents, who "used to do it all, are stepping more into the wings each year."

In the early or late 1940's — the Allans don't know the date for sure — Mrs. Allan's father, Harry Pomeran, bought what was then a 70-acre farm in Bellport, intending to run a hotel on it. Mrs. Allan's sister, Sally Harris, who is now the head of the drama department in a junior college in Baltimore, wanted to convert the barn into a theater.

Thus in the true tradition of the movies — "Hey, let's put on a show" — a summer stock theater, circa 1950, was born.

Adding to the aura of family, Mrs. Allan's sister met her husband, Les Harris, while they were appearing in "Tea and Sympathy" at the playhouse. Her brother, David Sheldon, who is now a producer living in Hollywood, met and married the actress Joan McCall, who was also in a Gateway play.

Mrs. Allan herself, once an actress at the Gateway in numerous plays "under several names," Ruth Vickers among them, met her husband, Stan, when he came to review a show there. Now the Town Clerk of Brookhaven, Mr. Allan was then working for a radio station in Patchogue.

Mr. and Mrs. Allan took over the theater from Mr. Pomeran in 1974, running it until 1980. Then, their son, Paul, and daughter, Robin, took over, with the Allans "close by." Mr. Pomeran died in 1977. Much of the land has been sold over the years; remaining are eight acres with 14 buildings.

One of them, the current Gateway Playhouse, was built in 1962, but the barn was used for several more years to present shows "in the round." Meanwhile, the new facility, with its proscenium stage, was also being used for such touring "star package" productions as "The Little Foxes" with Geraldine Page, "Don't Drink the Water" with Hans Conreid and "Black Comedy" with Dick Shawn.

Preceding the "new" stage, Robert Duvall, who won the year's Oscar as best actor for the film "Tender Mercies," and Gene Hackman, an Oscar winner for "The French Connection," appeared at the barn and were enrolled in the theater's training program. Now daily classes — in voice, dance and acting — are held in the barn.

Mrs. Allan attended Principia College in Illinois with Mr. Duvall and appeared as Stella opposite his

Stanley Kowalski in a Gateway production of "A Streetcar Named Desire." Mr. Duvall played in 19 productions at the Gateway, including a revival of "A View From the Bridge." Years later, it became a landmark Off Broadway production for which Dustin Hoffman was the stage manager.

The theater remains a showcase for new talent. "Just about every musical on Broadway has a Gateway Alumnus in it," Mr. Hodge asserted, citing Charles Wright in "Dreamgirls" as a case in point. "Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat," was this season's "hottest show," according to Mr. Hodge — "Pump Boys and Dinettes," which Mr. Hodge said was "pumpeo up with a live car and spinning sets," and "Seven Brides for Seven Brothers" were this summer's other shows.

With a new publicity push, reaching from Huntington to the Hamptons, an upsurge is expected for next year, when an original musical "Naughty Girl," is planned. Several years ago, a new rock-and-roll musical, "Neon," was tried out at the playhouse.

Mr. Allan, who received a degree in theater arts from the State University of New York at Stony Brook this year, conceded that repairs, renovations and refurbishing are necessary in several of the buildings.

Technically, Mr. Allan said, the theater is becoming stronger; in recent years, the number of lights and fly lines for scenery has doubled.

Recalling how he filled in for the lighting board operator at the age of 14 and performed in "The Sound of Music" at 8 and "Mame" at 10, he said: "I want to make the Gateway more well known. This has been my life; when my grandfather ran it, I'd come over, enthralled by theater. Now, I know this is it for me."

"It's his baby now," Mr. Allan affirmed. ■
