WHO'S WHO (in alphabetical order)

HAL BLANKENSHIP (*Col. Pickering*) has appeared in a wide variety of roles, ranging from the Duke of Kent in KING LEAR to Clem Rogers in THE WILL ROGERS FOLLIES. Some of his favorite roles—and there are many—include Abner in 42nd STREET, Col. Brackett in SOUTH PACIFIC, Babcock and Beauregard in MAME (Gateway Playhouse, 1970!), Sheriff Talbot in ORPHEUS DESCENDING, and Gen. Ulysses S. Grant in THE NINTH OF APRIL. Hal has appeared in all the New York daytime TV dramas, but none equal his appearance as Santa Claus in the Christmas '94 episode of "Another World." John would like to thank his parents and his sweetheart for their love, support, and prayers.

ROBERT BRIA (*Ensemble*) is originally from Redding, Connecticut, and is happy to be making his Gateway debut. Bob was last seen in CLOSER THAN EVER at Danbury Actors Repertory Theatre. DIMITRI CHRISTY (*Alfred Doolittle*) is thrilled to be a part of this production. Most recently, he has appeared in regional theatre as Henry (the Old Actor) in THE FANTASTICKS, Mr. Velasco in BAREFOOT IN THE PARK, a Pirate in PETER PAN, and in the title role in ZORBA (the musical).
