



# Behind The Scenes Of Beauty And The Beast Costumes, Make-Up, Wigs

Make-up for both Lefou and the Beast call for prosthetics. Prosthetics are artificial extensions that replace a body part. There must be new prosthetics built for every performance... Lefou has a prosthetic nose, and the beast has a prosthetic forehead, nose, and chin. They are made using actual molds of the actors face!



After up to THREE fittings per actor, per costume, at an average of FOUR costumes per actor, the wardrobe department makes alterations and prepares the nearly 100 COSTUMES which it also maintains throughout production.



It takes one make-up artist one hour to complete the Beast's make-up! His beard and eyebrows were hand laced (each hair individually tied to lace) and took over nine hours to make!

The two of the more than forty wigs in the show that were hand laced took over 12 hours of work a piece!






