It is our pleasure to welcome you to *Cabaret* as part of our 69th season. The Gateway legacy of bringing together top notch artistic talent together with a cast filled with Broadway professionals has set Gateway apart year after year.

While that is going on in Patchogue, we will be gearing up in Bellport for our annual Haunted House attraction, followed by our theatrical Fall/Holiday season featuring *Beauty and the Beast*.

Here's a hint at more things to come. For the first time we will be offering a full Winter/Spring series of events. Beginning in January, the Gateway stage will be hosting theatrical productions and special events up until May, when the 2019 series of hit Broadway musicals begins. Gateway will now have something to offer all year long! The season will be announced in August.
