

We are proud to present the regional premiere, and honored to have Sally Struthers join an incredibly talented cast of characters in the hilarious whodunit, Clue. Andrew Lloyd Webbers masterpiece Evita is next, followed by two more Long Island premieres — The Donna Summer Musical and the show everyone has been waiting for, Jersey Boys. Our legacy of presenting plays and musicals began almost 75 years ago. Our mission continues as we produce the highest quality shows on our stage, modeled after a typical Broadway theater - complete with an orchestra pit, fly system, wing space, and a fly loft. We are not limited to small scale scenery, lighting, and effects and often bring in the actual Broadway sets and costumes.

Most of the actors you see on our stage live in NYC where almost 50% of all US professional actors reside. We are fortunate enough to be situated so close to New York where we audition and interview hundreds of professional actors each year. This rigorous process takes a month or more as we narrow down the selections in our quest to find the most talented and uniquely suited characters for each of our shows. You may be surprised at the scope of our operation. We maintain a full-time production and administrative staff and it takes a team of over 60 people to run and maintain a Gateway show. Most of the cast and crew reside in buildings located throughout our 5-acre property where we also maintain our set, costume, and prop facilities as well as two rehearsal studios.

Plans are underway for a massive lobby and front of house renovation including 9,000 square feet of additional lobby space that will include lounging areas, new refreshment and bar areas, and will also include four season indoor/outdoor areas. This will be funded in part by a New York State Arts Capital Grant, matched by individual donors. You may not be aware that the price of admission only covers about 75% of our operating expenses. Donor support is vital to our continued success. We will continue our fundraising efforts throughout the summer and are looking for additional corporate and individual sponsors interested in becoming part of this exciting new capital campaign.
