Also this summer, teachers from the Gateway Acting School have conducted a series of acting workshops at the Boys and Girls Club of the Bellport Area. These sessions, available for all club members, help students reach their potential by giving them an outlet for their creativity. In the future months, multiple scholarships to the Gateway Acting School will be awarded to select participants, as a direct result of funds raised from our 2013 Gala.

I hope you will join us later this summer at our fourth annual gala, The Unusual Ball. This benefit, held on August 23, will be an evening of food, fun, fashion and finery. Please join us in your summer cocktail attire (or your eclectic finest!) for the party of the summer. Our shows and community outreach efforts would not be possible without your support.
